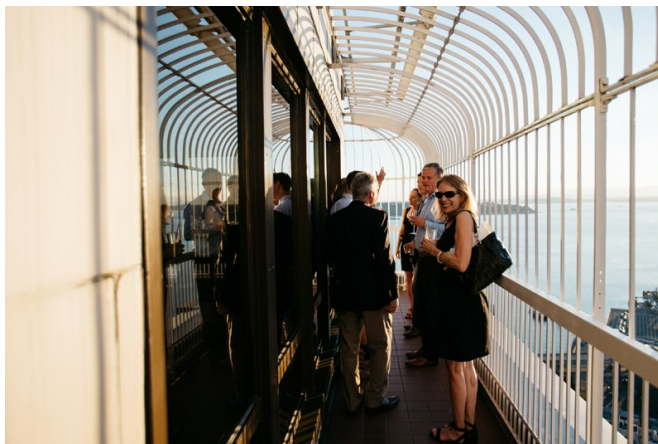
Hello Everyone!
